WESTMINSTER ABBEY DONATES A SPECIAL CROSS FOR ONESTONEGROVE

The Dean of Westminster Abbey visited OneStonegrove to present the church community with a freestanding cross. The Mayor of Barnet, Councillor David Longstaff, joined the congregation, guests and residents for a special service to mark the occasion.



The Dean of Westminster, The Very Reverend Dr John Hall, said: "The OneStonegrove project demonstrates the important relationship between local churches and their communities, and we're very pleased to be able to recognise the vital work carried out here through the donation of a freestanding cross. We pray for the continued success of OneStonegrove and the significant positive impact it has on the local community in Edgware."

The Mayor of Barnet, Councillor David Longstaff, said: "It's a real honour to receive recognition from Westminster Abbey for our fantastic joint community and church centre here in Edgware. This project was made possible by community spirit, co-operation and partnership and demonstrates that the community and the church can work together to make a real difference in the lives of residents"

The cross is used as part of St Peter's worship services from 10.30am on Sundays in the Wilberforce Hall and during the week it is kept in the chapel which is always available for private prayer and meditation.

EASTER WITH A DIFFERENCE AT ONESTONEGROVE

This year's Holy Week and Easter celebrations made full use of the building, starting with a wonderful art exhibition produced by artists of all ages in collaboration with local artist Esperanza Herschel. There were moving meditative services in an Upper Room on Maundy Thursday and then with the new cross in the main room on Good Friday. The joy of Easter was shared with young and old at the Messy Easter family fun service on Easter Saturday including more opportunities for creativity with special biscuits and a donkey race round the outside play area standing in for Jerusalem.

The congregation felt the excitement of Easter Sunday when young people burst in to the service and took them to the 'empty tomb' recreated in the chapel before hearing St Peter's original bell from the old church ring for the first time in over 30 years.

The next special event at St Peter's is Messy Church at Pentecost with the theme of the Biggest Birthday Party Ever. This fun filled family event is on Saturday 3 June from 12.00 to 2.00pm. Everyone is welcome!

We value each and every child within our nursery and plan for them individually as we understand all children's learning may take different paths. We work closely with the Early Years Foundation Stage when planning for our children, this ensures we are providing the best possible care for the children.

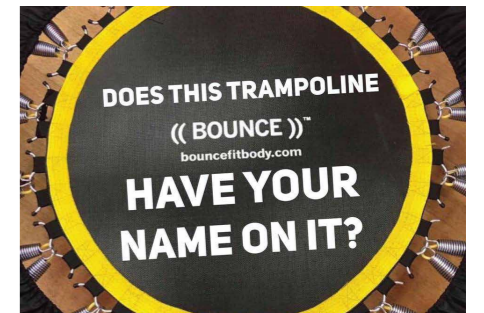
We believe that children learn through their interest and so we scaffold their learning through this. We plan fun and exciting activities based on the children's learning. This term we have been looking at bubbles. The children have really enjoyed this. It has progressed the younger children's speech and has challenged the older children's thinking as we experiment with different materials, solutions and tools. The children have guided their own learning by expressing their own interests such as sea life, washing the dolls and also the weather.



We are based in one big room, with a separate area for under 2's. We believe this is important as children learn from one another and it ensures that there is a smooth transition from our Caterpillars (under 2's) to our Butterflies (over 2's). We aim to provide an environment for the children that is welcoming and inclusive by including under 2's in as many activities as appropriate, such as listening walks, planting in our allotment, story time and meal times. We are open from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 51 weeks of the year, excluding bank holidays and three staff training days.
