## Listening campaign

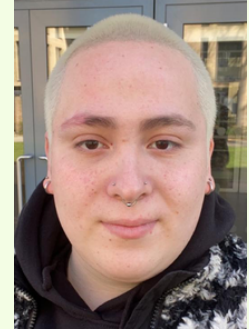
